We'll begin Kajiwara's story with him as a feudal warrior fighting in the Genpei War (1180 – 1185). The Genpei War is being fought between two clans, the Taira (Heike) and the Minamoto (Genji), for control of Japan. Kajiwara enters as a general on the side of the Taira. The Minamoto clan is led by Minamoto-no-Yoritomo. At the Battle of Ishi-bashiyama (1181) near Hakone, the Taira are triumphant, and Yoritomo and his army flee. Kajiwara is sent with a search party to find Yoritomo. They think they have found him and his companions hiding in a cave. Kajiwara investigates and does find Yoritomo there but strikes a deal with him. Upon

exiting the cave, Kajiwara reports to the others that Yoritomo is not there, and, from the spider webs he saw, no one could have entered recently.
